ips gun safe Mysterious sniper weapons had been used in the St. Petersburg attack, the Guardian reported. The newspaper said Russian security forces have claimed they seized this type of weapon at the scene of the attack. RT.com contacted local newspaper Gazeta.ru, which in turn contacted the Interior Ministry's investigative committee. "The problem that we have here is that we do not see how it is possible to shoot from here [16 cm]. The object we found in the building could only have been fired from the ledge [of the building]. It is improbable that the terrorist was firing from up there," one unnamed source said. The St. Petersburg subway attack was carried out by a female suicide bomber. She detonated an explosive belt at the station named for the war hero Admiral Vasily Golitsyn, which is located on the grounds of the Russian White House, a building which houses the headquarters of the FSB, the security service of the Russian Federation. The armed service suspected that she was carrying out a

terrorist act and shot her down, authorities said. In the aftermath of the attack, security services claimed they had uncovered an armed terrorist cell, and one of its members had betrayed its comrades. Several Russian media outlets reported that a female suicide bomber was killed by the security forces while trying to escape. The Prosecutor General's office, however, issued a different version of the events, saying that one terrorist had been detained alive after the attacks. The Russian Interior Ministry later presented evidence that the detained man had handed over intelligence information to the terrorist cell. The ministry did not reveal the evidence, stating that the detentions had been made to protect the lives of the public. The Russian security services have confirmed a second terror attack on Monday morning, when a female suicide bomber struck a bus stop near the city's busy Nevsky prospekt, a major thoroughfare. The self-proclaimed Islamic State (IS, formerly ISIS/ISIL) terror group claimed responsibility for both terrorist attacks, according to a statement released by the group's Amaq news agency. The FSB said the first attacker was killed before she could detonate her explosive belt, but the second suicide bomber was shot by security forces after she detonated her belt at a bus stop. Russian President Vladimir Putin condemned the attacks, which have killed at least 14 people and injured over 40. "Our countrymen are dying. We must do everything 82157476af
